



The Surround Zone - SADiE 5 Installation Guide

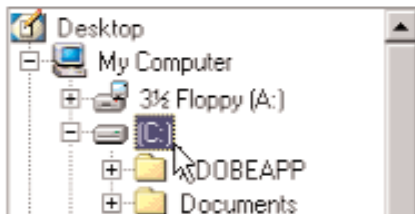
Before downloading or installing The Surround Zone, you will need to contact your dealer to purchase it, if you have not done so already. You will either be sent a Surround Zone CD-ROM, or you can download the installer from www.soundfield.com, or install it from your SADiE v5 Software CD-ROM. You will be sent a password via e-mail - if it is sent to a machine other than that on which the Plugin will be installed, you will need to note it down or save it to a txt file on floppy disk, using Notepad.

INSTALLING FROM THE SOUNDFIELD SURROUND ZONE CD-ROM

Open Windows Explorer, by right-clicking the **My Computer** icon on your desktop and selecting **Explore** from the menu that appears. Select your CD-ROM drive by clicking once in the left-hand pane. The CD-ROM will contain a **.exe** file relevant to the Plugin you wish to install. Double clicking on this file will start the installation process for the Plugin software. During installation you will be asked to enter your plug-in password. Copy the password from your email or txt file. If you are entering it manually, do so carefully, and note that it is case sensitive.

INSTALLING FROM THE SADIE SOFTWARE CD-ROM

Insert the CD-ROM in to your drive. A pop up menu dialogue should appear automatically. Go to **Software**, then **Plugins**. Click the button for the relevant Plugin. This will start the installation process for the Plugin software. Follow the instructions on screen. If your Plugin password is included on the CD-ROM, the Plugin will install automatically without further input. If it is not included on the CD-ROM, you will be asked to enter your Plugin password during installation. Copy the password from your email or txt file. If you are entering it manually, do so carefully, and note that it is case sensitive.



INSTALLING FROM THE SADIE WEB SITE

• CREATING A STORAGE DIRECTORY

Open Windows Explorer, by right-clicking the **My Computer** icon on your desktop and selecting **Explore** from the menu that appears.

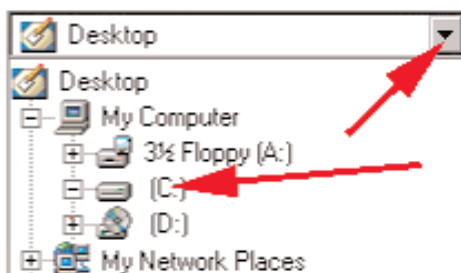


Click once on the C: drive in the left-hand pane.

From the **File** menu, select **New**, then **Folder**. A new icon will appear in the right-hand pane, ready to rename. Call this folder something appropriate like **SADiE Install**.

DOWNLOADING FROM THE WEB SITE

Go to www.sadie.com and go to the software download page. Click on the **bold lilac link** to download the relevant Plugin. After a short pause, you will be offered the option of saving the file to disk (this is normally the default). Select **OK** and you will be asked where you want to save the file. Select the **SADiE Install** directory you created earlier from the drop down box.



Your browser will now copy the file to your hard disk. The speed of this download will depend on your Internet service provider, the time of day, and your modem specification.

INSTALLING

Go back to Windows Explorer, and find your **SADiE Install** directory. It will now contain a **.exe** file relevant to your selected Plugin. Double clicking on this file will start the installation process for the Plugin software. Follow the instructions on screen. When asked for your password, copy it from your email or txt file. If you are entering it manually, do so carefully, and note that it is case sensitive. Once you are satisfied that the installation has been successful you can delete the **.exe** file (and the folder if desired) to conserve space on your hard disk. This can be done in Windows Explorer by highlighting clicking on each of the files in turn and pressing the Delete key on your keyboard. Alternatively, leave them in place to save further downloads.
